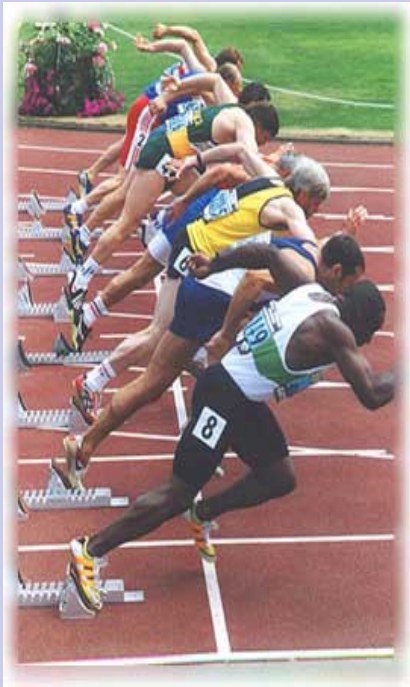


Are you interested in becoming an NCAA student-athlete?

NCAA Academic Eligibility Requirements

Division I - Graduates 2008 and after

If you enroll in a Division I college on or after August 1, 2007 and want to participate in athletics or receive an athletics scholarship, you must meet the following academic standards:

- Graduate from high school;
- Complete the 16 core courses listed below;
- Earn a minimum required GPA in your core courses; and
- Achieve a combined ACT or SAT sum score that matches your core GPA as found on the NCAA Clearinghouse website.

16 Required Core Courses

- Four years of English;
- Three years of math (Algebra I or higher);
- Two years of natural or physical science (including one year of lab science);
- One extra year of English, math or science;
- Two years of social science; and
- Four years of extra core courses (from any category above, or foreign language)

Division II

If you enroll in a Division II college in 2005 or later and want to participate in athletics or receive an athletic scholarship, you must meet the following academic standards:

- Graduate from high school;
- Complete the 14 core courses listed below;
- Earn a 2.000 GPA in your core courses; and
- Achieve a sum score of 68 on your ACT subtests or a SAT score of 820.

14 Required Core Courses

- Three years of English;
- Two years of math (Algebra I or higher);
- Two years of natural or physical science (including one year of lab science);
- Two years of English, math or natural or physical science;
- Two years of social science; and
- Three years of core courses (from any category above, or foreign language)

Division III

Contact your Division III college regarding its policies on financial aid, practice and competition.

Core Courses

Check your high school's list of core courses at the clearinghouse website at www.ncaaclearinghouse.net

On the **General Information** page of that website, select **List of Approved Core Courses**, type **I43270** under school code. Or, you can ask your Guidance Counselor.

Test Score Requirements

ACT or SAT scores must be submitted to the NCAA Clearinghouse directly from the testing agencies. When registering for these tests, student-athletes should select the Clearinghouse (code 9999) as a score recipient.

Clearinghouse Registration

Register for the NCAA Clearinghouse at the beginning of the Junior year of high school. Students must register online at www.ncaaclearinghouse.net.

Select **Prospective Student-Athletes** and click on **Domestic Student Release Form**. Print both copy 1 and copy 2 of the transcript release form, sign them and return both forms to your high school.
